The following message shall be read to the Head Coaches & Team Captains prior to each contest officiated by a PIAA Registered Official. This message shall be enforced by Contest officials & its enforcement shall include a strict & swift D/Q when unsportsmanlike actions/remarks demean the racial or ethnic background of any party.

“PIAA requires all registered sports officials to enforce the Sportsmanship rules for Coaches & Contestants. Actions meant to demean opposing contestants, teams, spectators, & officials

are not in the highest ideals of interscholastic education & will not be tolerated. Let today's contest reflect mutual respect. Coaches please certify to the Contest Official(s) that your contestants are legally equipped & uniformed according to NFHS Rules & PIAA Adoptions. Good Luck in today's contest

Coaches must verbally certify compliance with NFHS rules when so asked during the reading of the message. This is a verbal agreement to comply with equipment and safety rules. It also assists in alleviating legal liability concerns for Officials in the event that a team subsequently violates the proper equipment provisions of the contest rules. It is a pro-active measure overall as well as a reminder of the expectations for good sportsmanship & conduct.
